Christmas Recipe:

Leftover Turkey Casserole:

- 2 cups cooked instant rice
- 2 cups cooked frozen peas
- 2-2 1/2 cups turkey pieces

If you like, you can add some mushrooms

1 can of cream of mushroom or cream of chicken soup

1/3 cup of milk

1/2 tsp. of salt

2/3 cup of grated cheese

Butter a 13 x 9 in. casserole dish

Put the rice in the bottom

Add a layer of cooked peas and mushrooms (if used)

Cover this with the turkey pieces

Mix up the soup, milk and salt + pour over turkey

Sprinkle the cheese on top

Bake at 375° F for 30-35 minutes until it is heated through.
